## What to Expect (Participant Guide)

### Welcome!

Your Corporate Showcase is designed as a low-risk, high-value way to experience equine-facilitated experiential learning and evaluate whether it's a fit for your organization and/or team. This is a hands-on experience (not a lecture). All activities are done safely on the ground—no riding required. Because the Showcase is intended for decision-makers to “test drive” the experience, participation is limited to no more than two people per organization.

### What You'll Do

- Participate in facilitated, ground-based activities with horses (no riding).
- Work through structured exercises that make team dynamics and leadership behaviors tangible in real time.
- Engage in guided reflection and debriefs that translate insights directly to workplace realities.
- Ask questions and discuss how equine-facilitated learning can support your goals (communication, trust, collaboration, decision-making, and more).

### What You'll Leave With

- A clear sense of whether this approach addresses the challenges your leaders and teams are facing.
- Language and examples you can use to describe the experience to stakeholders.
- A recommended next-step path (if you choose) for bringing an equine-facilitated session to your team.

### What to Wear & Bring

- Closed-toe shoes (required). NOTE: You will not be able to participate if you wear open-toed shoes.
- Comfortable, weather-appropriate clothing you can move in (layers recommended). A light jacket/rain layer if the forecast suggests it (some arenas are covered but not climate-controlled).
- Water bottle (optional—water will typically be available).



## Arrival & Timing

Please plan to arrive 10–15 minutes early to settle in, meet the facilitators, and review safety guidelines. If you anticipate arriving late, contact us as soon as possible: (317) 771 6717

## Safety, Comfort & Accessibility

- You'll receive a brief safety orientation before activities begin.
- No horse experience is required; facilitators provide clear guidance throughout.
- If you have allergies, please be sure to take or bring your allergy medication. As a working farm, you will be exposed to hay, grasses, horses, dogs and cats..
- If you have mobility issues, please contact us to discuss. Due to the nature of the arena, we are not able to accommodate wheel chairs, unless they have off-road capabilities.

## Quick FAQ

- Do we ride? No. All activities are ground-based and focus on human skills rather than horsemanship.
- Is this therapy? No. This is a leadership and team development experience, not counseling or psychotherapy.
- What about weather? Many sessions occur in covered arenas. Dress for the forecast; details will be shared in your logistics email.
- Can I bring a colleague? Yes, and they need to be registered as well, due to the limited space.

## Optional: Quick Reflection Before You Arrive

*If you have two minutes, consider the questions below. They will help you get more value from the Showcase:*

- Where do we see communication breakdowns most often (within teams, across teams, or up/down the org)?
- What decisions are consistently slow or unclear—and what tends to get in the way?
- Where is trust strong today, and where does it feel fragile or inconsistent?
- What would “better collaboration” look like in measurable terms over the next 90 days?
